TERMS & CONDITIONS

Mission Statement

Develop and preserve an outstanding system of facilities, parks, and recreational programs for the Town of Coventry.

Core Values

The Coventry Parks and Recreation Department will be a premier parks and recreation department in Rhode Island. We will improve the health of our citizens through programs that encourage staying active and fit. We will connect all citizens to our community by offering programs that encourage inclusion and participation. Finally, we will provide a wide variety of activities that encourage all segments of our population to use their free time both positively and productively, and promote life-long learning through recreational and cultural programs.

REFUNDS

Participants will receive a refund when a program is cancelled due to lack of participants, facilities, or qualified instruction. Refunds for payments made by cash or check will be issued in the form of a check. Refunds for payments made by a credit card will be issued to the credit card minus a 3% service charge. A \$30 service fee will be charged for any checks returned from the bank. Registrations are non-transferable. Refunds take approximately 3-4 weeks to be processed. **If a child/adult is asked to leave a program, no refunds will be provided.**

CANCELLATIONS

The Coventry Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel a program due to insufficient registration, or any other cause, that prevents the presentation of an activity in an acceptable manner. If a session is cancelled due to inclement weather, instructor illness, etc., a make-up date may be scheduled to honor the original number of sessions. Visit coventryrecreation.org and our social media pages for the most up-to-date cancellation information.

Low Enrollment

Classes that do not meet the minimum enrollment are not the best use of our limited resources, and usually are not very fun for the community. Classes with low enrollment will be notified that the class is in danger of being cancelled two weeks prior to the class starting. The actual class will be cancelled within one week prior to the scheduled start date and a full refund or account credit will be issued. The Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to reschedule, postpone, combine, or change classes. You will be notified via email or phone call if your class is cancelled; otherwise plan on attending.

LATE POLICY

If after 20 minutes from when the class starts, and NOBODY has shown up, the instructor or attendant will lock up and cancel class.

Make-Up Classes

All attempts will be made to reschedule classes that have been cancelled due to inclement weather, instructor absence, or other unforeseen circumstances. Typically a program that meets weekly will extend another week at the same day and time. Check with your instructor to confirm. Classes missed due to participant absence because of scheduling conflicts or personal reasons cannot be made up. **If a make-up class cannot be scheduled, a pro-rated refund or credit will not be provided.**

Drop-Off Programs

Parents/Guardians of Children under 5 years of age participating in our programs are required to accompany their child (ren) to and from the location of the program (i.e. class rooms, gymnasium, etc.) and must remain on the premises should they be needed. Should a parent or guardian leave the area of the program, they MUST inform the instructor where they can be found, including contact information. This procedure has been established for the protection and safety of all children within Parks & Recreation programs.

Photo/Video Policy

The Parks & Recreation Department may make, have, use, publish, and reproduce photographs and/or videos of participants for its record, public relations purposes, recognition and/or other projects related to the wholesome promotion of its program unless permission is denied in writing.

Inclement Weather Policy

All classes (day and evening) will be canceled when Coventry Public Schools are closed. If Coventry Public Schools have delayed opening, all Parks & Recreation department programs will still start on their regularly scheduled time, unless you are informed otherwise. In the event we need to cancel evening or weekend classes, it will be listed on our website and social media pages. We will also attempt to email participants who have registered for these classes.

Room and Park Rentals

Parks and facilities run by the Coventry Parks and Recreation Department are available for private rentals. Reservations may be made once all recreation programming is in place. Please stop by the Guy L. Lefebvre Community Center to pick up a facility rental form or give us a call to inquire at (401)822-9107.

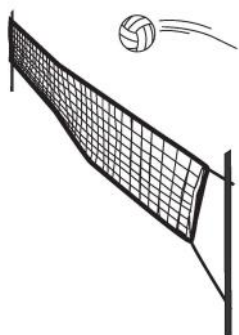

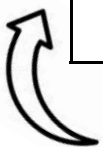

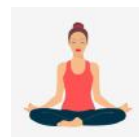
